Hi Matt,

Thanks for your email.

As noted in your comments the archaeological evaluation report was submitted as part of the outline application 22/00277/OUT. In response to these results our recommendation was for further mitigation comprising the excavation of an area where significant archaeological remains were identified during the evaluation. I have attached these comments to this email, for reference.

The archaeological condition (18) therefore requires the submission of a Written Scheme of Investigation (WSI) outlining these further mitigation works, followed by the completion of the works outlined within the approved WSI. At present I can confirm that we are yet to see a copy of a WSI outlining a satisfactory programme of work for the archaeological mitigation. As such we would reiterate our comments for the above application and advise the applicant that Condition 18 of the outline permission remains outstanding.
