Thank you for your consultation in respect of the above planning application. The County Council has considered the application, having regard to the Development Plan, National Planning Policy Guidance and other relevant material considerations. In this particular instance, the County Council, as Minerals and Waste Planning Authority (MWPA), comments as follows;

The development site is located within a mineral safeguarding area for Igneous rock. However, upon review of the proposals, it is considered unlikely that extraction of the mineral would occur in the future at the site given its proximity to existing residential development and its locations at the edge of the recorded deposit. Therefore, a Mineral Assessment is not required for this proposal. Additionally, the site is not located near any waste sites therefore, the MWPA does not have any objections from a mineral and waste safeguarding perspective.
