Thank you for your consultation in respect of the above planning application. The County Council has considered the application, having regard to the Development Plan, National Planning Policy Guidance and other relevant material considerations. In this particular instance, the County Council, as Minerals and Waste Planning Authority, comments as follows:

The development site is located within a minerals safeguarding area for Sand & Gravel. However, the development is in the spirit of LMWLP Policy M11 Table 4 exemption (b) '*applications for alterations and extensions to existing buildings and for change of use of existing development, unless intensifying activity on site*' as it is for the demolition and replacement of an existing derelict house. As such, and as there is existing development on the site which has essentially already sterilised any mineral, the County Council has no objections to the proposal.
