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Comments Details

Comments:

I have no objection to the principle of the development. The Phase II investigation highlights that hydrocarbons were found in soils in excess of water industry thresholds for the use of PE pipes and protective measures may be required- The report should be brought to the attention of Severn Trent.

The Phase II states that piled foundations or other form of ground improvement will be required and vibration from any ground improvement/piling operations likely to give rise to vibration should be considered in a Construction Environmental Management Plan for the site.

I recommend a CEMP is conditioned for the site due to the proximity of existing residential premises and the likely timescale of the construction phase.

Recommended Conditions:
CONSTRUCTION
a) Prior to commencement of development a Construction Environmental Management Plan shall be submitted to and agreed in writing by the LPA. The plan shall detail how, during the site preparation and construction phase of the development, the impact on existing and proposed residential premises and the environment shall be prevented or mitigated from dust, odour, noise, smoke, light and land contamination. The plan shall detail how such controls will be monitored. The plan will provide a procedure for the investigation of complaints.
b) The agreed details shall be implemented throughout the course of the development.

Monday – Friday 07:30 – 18:00
Saturday 08:00 – 13:00
No working on Sundays and Bank Holidays
