Comments:	LAND CONTAMINATION The report details (A) below on page 4 but following further sampling the report states that there are no elevated levels across the site. However, it is not detailed how the below will be addressed; this information is required and until that time, my recommended conditions stand.
	(A) From the five samples recovered for testing, significantly elevated levels of arsenic and diabenze(a,h)anthracene were recorded across two of the samples. Furthermore, none of the samples were recorded to contain asbestos. At this stage in the investigation a basic clean cover system was recommended.
	Ground gas monitoring is continuing and an addendum report will be submitted; until this is submitted Condition 77 is still recommended.
	Condition 75 will always be recommended, regardless of the above.
	CONSTRUCTION It is recommended that on-site activities are limited to 08:00-13:00 on Saturday.
